Coccinelle rounded off its sales streak by signing a deal with SKY Germany for its 16 classical music documentaries *The Secret of Classical Music*, together with its best-selling Spanish documentary about young circus acrobats, *Grazing the Sky* (directed by **Horacio Alcalá**), and *Undue Debt*, a documentary by award-winning Italian director **Andrea Segre** around bankrupt Greece, following the words, thoughts and music of Rebetiko, a Hellenic brand of folk-blues made by outcasts and rebels.
